Bow Pulpit in s/s, with red/green navigation lights  
Stern Pulpit in s/s with ring buoy and flag staff supports  
Self bailing anchor well with mooring line hook  
Varnished wood toe rail with molded anodized aluminum fairleads, amidships and aft.  
Stainlees steel profiled stanchions, height 2.07' with molded aluminum chainplates.  
Twin sets of adjustable stainless steel lifelines.  
(4) Anodized aluminum mooring cleats.  
(2) Stainlees steel handrails on coachroof.  
(2) 4-sheave horizontal turning blocks leading lines to cockpit.
